

RESURRECTION IKON

The ikon of the Resurrection of Christ, commissioned from Efrem Carrasco, is now ready. This magnificent ikon has been photographed and cards are now being printed. These will be available in packs of five, together with envelopes, and will retail at £1.50 per pack. Profits from the sale of the cards will go into the Mettingham Orthodox Trust savings account for the various renovations and development projects that are currently in hand.

COLLEGE WORKS IN PROGRESS

The vegetation against the walls of the building has now been substantially removed to allow access to the walls for essential cleaning, repairs and repainting. Further to this, in this area the public roads have given the impression of being the world capital of mud in the past few months. This has had a detrimental effect of the

driveway. A truckload of shingle has been delivered to refresh the surface of the drive and the car park. Any surplus will be used on the paths around the church and elsewhere in the grounds. At the time of writing, this work is about to begin but it might ultimately require a further truckload to complete the job.
