

These are available in small packets @ £3 each or £28 for a box weighing one kilo. Since churches are closed for public services, no candles are being ordered, which is unusual at what is normally the busiest time of the year. The bookshop is closed to the public. Yet, because both the internet and the post office are both functioning, book sales have greatly increased.

Every evening, compline, the Akathist to the Mother of God Joy of All Who Sorrow and intercessions, take place in church. We continue to pray for all who are in need. Most Holy Theotokos, save us!
