Notes & Jottings

SAINT WANDREGISILIUS

Our good friend in Switzerland, Subdeacon Claude Lopez, has donated a relic of St Wandregisilius (a small fragment of bone) to us. We greatly appreciate his generosity because we have a special devotion to this inspiring 7th Century saint. We are blessed to have a spectacular ikon of St Wandregeilsilus in the church which was given by Mary McCabe in memory of Mary our foundress.

COLLEGE DEVELOPMENTS

Before the beginning of Great Lent, a complete set of white vestments was ordered from Kiev. Unhappily, the war broke out and prevented the vestments from arriving in time for Pascha. They eventually arrived two weeks ago and were first worn on All Saints Day.

The major renovations, to make the building weatherproof before next winter, will begin in July. Meanwhile, Yakov has repainted the inside of the east porch and the storm doors. This was a much-needed task and it now looks vastly improved. He has also cut down a large old Bramley apple tree in the corner of the churchyard. It had been dead for several years but now will provide winter firewood.

INFLATION

As inflation feeds through the economic system, we are going to find that life will become tougher. We had no choice but to adjust the pricing of candles, which are a source of income. As from 1 June, votive candles are retailing at £16 per 100 and churches, ordering in bulk, will be eligible for a 15% discount.

Inflation is also affecting the book business. At the time of writing (27 June) we are looking towards Sunday 3 July when we celebrate All Saints of Britain and Ireland. We this in mind, we have increased the number of titles in stock relating to local saints and at the end of the bulletin you will find a complete list with order form.

We have recently heard that the May volume of the Lives of Saints by St Dmitri Rostovsky has now been published. It retails at \$33 (£27 at present exchange rates). Whilst we would like to stock it, these are heavy books and the cost of transporting them for the USA will be extortionate. This is causing us to hesitate. Unfortunately, this problem is affecting all imported titles from America.

Of our own publications, there is news. Two small A6 size booklets will be reprinted. These are *A Month with St Seraphim* and *A Month with St John of Kronstadt*. A few years ago, the text of a third booklet in this series, *A Month with St John the Wonderworker*, was prepared. It was not published at the time but it could be published this year. In addition to this, we have the text of an *Akathist to St Walstan of Taverham* (one of our most local saints) and an *Akathist to St Cedd of Essex*. These could both be published.
