# A Pastoral Word from Fr Mark

#### **AGM**

After lunch on Sunday 26 March, the Sunday of the Cross, the parish had its first AGM. The meeting began with prayer and Fr Mark invited Fr Dcn Andrew to give an historical overview of the creation of the community and the vision of his late wife, Mary Bond our foundress. Fr Mark then proposed Maria Dive as Starosta and Daniel Price as Secretary-cum-Treasurer which was universally accepted with no objections. Fr Mark will now formally write to Vladyka Irenei asking for this proposal to be formally approved by him. Many different items were discussed covering practical topics such as the timing of church services, managing confessions, to the possibility of new mid-week services as well as potential plans for pilgrimages and ways of reaching out to new people. Fr Mark expressed his gratitude to all who made a special effort to attend the AGM and for the peaceful and constructive tone of the discussions before ending the meeting with a prayer.


