PATRONAL FEAST AT OUR CATHEDRAL

Fr Mark and family went to our beautiful diocesan cathedral in London for the Altar Feast of the Nativity of the Mother of God on Thursday 21st September. It was wonderful to concelebrate with Vladyka Irenei and all the Cathedral clergy as well as other visiting clergy from around the diocese including Fr Paul Elliott from Wallasey, Fr Robert Williams from Clifden (Ireland), Hieromonk Mark (Underwood) from Cardiff as well as Fr Aleksandr Groves from St Leonard's on Sea. Many thanks to Vladyka, the clergy and sisterhood for welcoming us again and for their hospitality.

FEAST OF OUR LADY OF WALSINGHAM

Following the Feast of the Nativity of the Mother of God, it was also a great joy to return back to England's Nazareth, the village of Little Walsingham in North Norfolk to celebrate the Feast of the Ikon of Our Lady of Walsingham on Saturday 23rd September. After a procession from the Slipper Chapel, Fr Mark with a small number of pilgrims served a moleben for the Ikon of OLW in the Holy House. We are grateful to the Shrine Administrators for this rare privilege and to Mother Melangell for organising the pilgrimage.

IKON TO ST VARUS & PRAYING FOR LOVED ONES OUTSIDE THE CHURCH

Fr Mark has had an ikon to the Martyr Varus commissioned for our church in memory of his Aunt Joyce and Uncle Denis Troup. The Martyr Varus is well known for the efficacy of his prayers for the salvation of those who die outside the Orthodox Church. We will start serving a regular service to St Varus for our departed non-Orthodox loved ones. We also hope to serve a Divine Liturgy in honour of St Varus on his feast day with our new ikon on Wednesday 1st November.

NEW HOLY OILS

We are very grateful to Irina Dembri who has recently returned from Russia with a large number of holy oils from the lampadas hanging over the relics of different saints including: St Seraphim of Sarov, St Luke the Surgeon, St Sergius of Radonezh and his parents Sts Cyril and Maria. We will use these to anoint the faithful during our Wednesday evening molebens over the coming months.

On **Wednesday 15**th **November** we will have Founder's Day where we will celebrate a Requiem Liturgy for the soul of Dcn Andrew's late wife, Mary Bond at 10.10am followed by a Litia at the grave and Memorial Meal. Notes & Jottings

CARDS

The new card is now being printed and will be added to the range of cards currently available. This one depicts an ikon of the Mother of God surrounded by six Scottish Saints, in the borders, and was written in St Seraphim's Studio at Walsingham. The cards will be blank inside so that they can be used for any occasion, including Christmas, and will be supplied with envelopes in packs of five retailing at £1.50 per pack.

THE WILLOW TREE

On Sunday 10 September the large willow tree, near our car park, unexpectedly broke on half and a large section of it fell onto the drive



causing a complete blockage. This happened at some time during the liturgy. By a great team effort with a chainsaw, it was possible to allow a passage for vehicular traffic. In the late afternoon of Holy Cross Day, Sergiu Sacaliuc arrived with a co-worker to cut up the largest fallen section which is now in woodpile in the corner of the carpark. When the wood is well seasoned, it will be useful for fuel in a wood-burning stove. The tree, which was planted 70 years ago, leans at precarious angle but fortunately it leans away from the carpark. If it leaned the other way, it would have fallen on to several cars that were parked there. As it was, no cars were damaged.

FOUNDER'S DAY

Founder's Day is on Wednesday 15 November and is the 13th anniversary of the repose of our Foundress, to whom we are deeply indebted. In founding this church, in honour of the Mother of God, it was Mary's wish to provide somewhere for people in this area to come and pray. The fact, that so many of you take advantage of this facility, is heart-warming. We cannot fail to notice the depth of your devotion because of your generosity to the church, both in time and material support. Strengthening our community all helps to raise the profile of Orthodox Christianity here, enabling us to reach out to more people. If Orthodoxy is to grow in this country, we need to be more visible, more pro-active; build churches, teach, preach, print and publish. Whilst we greatly value the church building, it is the living community that is Mary's true memorial.

FILMING
