### FEAST OF NATIVITY & THEOPHANY

After the service a magnificent Christmas lunch was served followed by carols and festive songs. On the Feast of Theophany itself we had a much smaller number of people present in church for the Liturgy and first Great Blessing of water. On the Sunday after Theophany another first for our parish was the Great Blessing of the River Waveney at Wainford Bridge. Although the weather was a little windy, we were able to complete the blessing without any mishap and three plucky souls plunged themselves three-times beneath the newly blessed water.
